## Town of Lyme Budget Committee October 9, 2019 7:00 PM

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 PM by Chair Jones

- 1. Mr. McClave moved to approve the minutes of the September 11, 2019 meeting. Seconded by Mr. Hayden. Voted unanimously in favor.
- 2. Tonight, will be a review of the 2020 proposed department budgets for the following departments:
  - Fire-Chief Mundy reviewed the Fire Department proposed 2020 budget.
  - Proposed New Fire House- Chief Mundy reviewed the fundraising efforts, potential costs, grants and the possible need for a warrant article to raise and appropriate what will be the balance needed for the new building after all fundraising efforts are exhausted.
  - 1.3 million total cost: Funding to come from the following sources:
    - > \$450,000 Capital Reserve Fund
    - > \$100,000 Swan Fund Grant
    - > \$100,000 matching donation
    - ➤ \$300,000+ goal for Fire Department Fundraising
    - ➤ Balance of project cost- Warrant article for 2020 Town meeting.

Chief Mundy will meet with the Select Board further down the fundraising efforts about what the possible amount needed for the warrant article.

- 3. The following topics were briefly reviewed:
  - Fast Squad- no change in requested budget amount
  - Ambulance- estimated 3% increase
  - Emergency Management Director-\$1,360.00
  - Health and Welfare: All budget requests have not come in to date.
- 4. Mr. Hayden gave a brief review of where the Collective Bargaining is at this point. The process was briefly reviewed.
- 5. The logistics of Town Meeting and School meeting taking place at the same time was discussed. Pros and Cons were discussed.
- 6. The 2018 audit notes an "adverse opinion" information was requested on this.
- 7. At 8:10PM Mr. Hayden moved to adjourn. Seconded by Mr. McClave.
