Site visit for the Hidden Valley bank stabilization project with Jim Kennedy and John Mudge (of the UVSC of the CRJC), feel that the current DES application and plan is overkill. Jim felt it could be stabilized by back filling the void at the river level and putting down fabric and rip rap to one foot above the high water mark without remodeling the entire bank. This would be much less costly and time consuming to accomplish. We did disagree when it came to planting large trees on top of the bank. Large trees on the riverbank would become a problem in the future.

Grant Brook Area Project, CLD has submitted a proposal to prepare the DES permit and plan to stabilize the bank at a cost of \$15,000. This proposal is to be reviewed by the Select Board at their next meeting.

Discussed the need for Warrant Articles to fund the necessary repairs and projects.

Reviewed the need to preserve a section of paved road each year. It was the consensus of those present to focus on the section of Goose Pond Road from Pico to Baker Hill for a preservation treatment in 2017.
