1. Ask Chief O'Keefe to send an e-mail reminding residents of the rules for the boat racks
2. You must be a Lyme resident to leave your boat at this area. This means you will need a Lyme resident sticker on your boat, your name and phone number.
3. All boats must be removed by the designated date or they will be removed by the Lyme Police department. \$100.00 fine is associated with this violation.

Discussed the use of the Ball field by the fighting gents. Adult soccer player. This will be a Recreation Commission sponsored sport. They must follow all Recreation Commission policies. The scheduling of games will be worked out and go through Steve Small the director. The application notes no firm dates yet but they are asking to schedule 5-7 games on the field.
