

CEMETERY REGULATIONS
LYME, NEW HAMPSHIRE

1. Lots are available to residents currently living in Lyme or former residents who have resided in Lyme for ten or more years as adults.
2. Lots may not be transferred from one individual to another but shall be released to the Cemetery Commission in writing.
3. A lot shall be used only for the interment of the applicant and/or members of the immediate family.
4. Allocation of lots will be made by the Sexton and lots will generally be assigned in sequence.
5. A maximum of four cremation urns will be permitted per single lot.
6. All interments, both vaults and urns, shall be under the direction of the Sexton.
7. The person to whom a lot is assigned is responsible for placing cornerstones under the supervision of the Sexton. If the cornerstones have not been placed within six months of purchase of the lot, the stones will be set in place by the Commission and billed to the owner.
8. One headstone per lot is allowed, however the number of flat markers per lot is at the discretion of the lot owner.
9. All headstones require cement foundations with a minimum four-inch margin on all sides.
10. The Cemetery Commission reserves the right of rejection or approval of all headstones and monuments.
11. No shrubs or trees may be planted by individuals; flowers only may be planted and only with the concurrence of the Sexton. The Cemetery Commission has the right to remove any plantings that have become unsightly, diseased, or detrimental.
12. All gravesite decorations, floral designs, both real and artificial, containers, and vases must be removed by November 1st or they will be taken away and confiscated by the Cemetery Commission. Christmas decorations must be removed by April 15th.
13. Winter interments are not permitted. The cemetery is open for burial from May first to November first.
14. No bicycles, motorcycles, snowmobiles, off-highway recreational vehicles or horses are allowed on cemetery property.
15. Flush markers in the Memorial Garden are 16x8x2 inches and are included in the fee. Lettering will be paid by the purchaser.
16. 4x3 foot cremation lots may contain up to 2 cremation urns and there may be only 1 headstone, no larger than 2 feet wide by 2 feet high by 1 foot deep.
