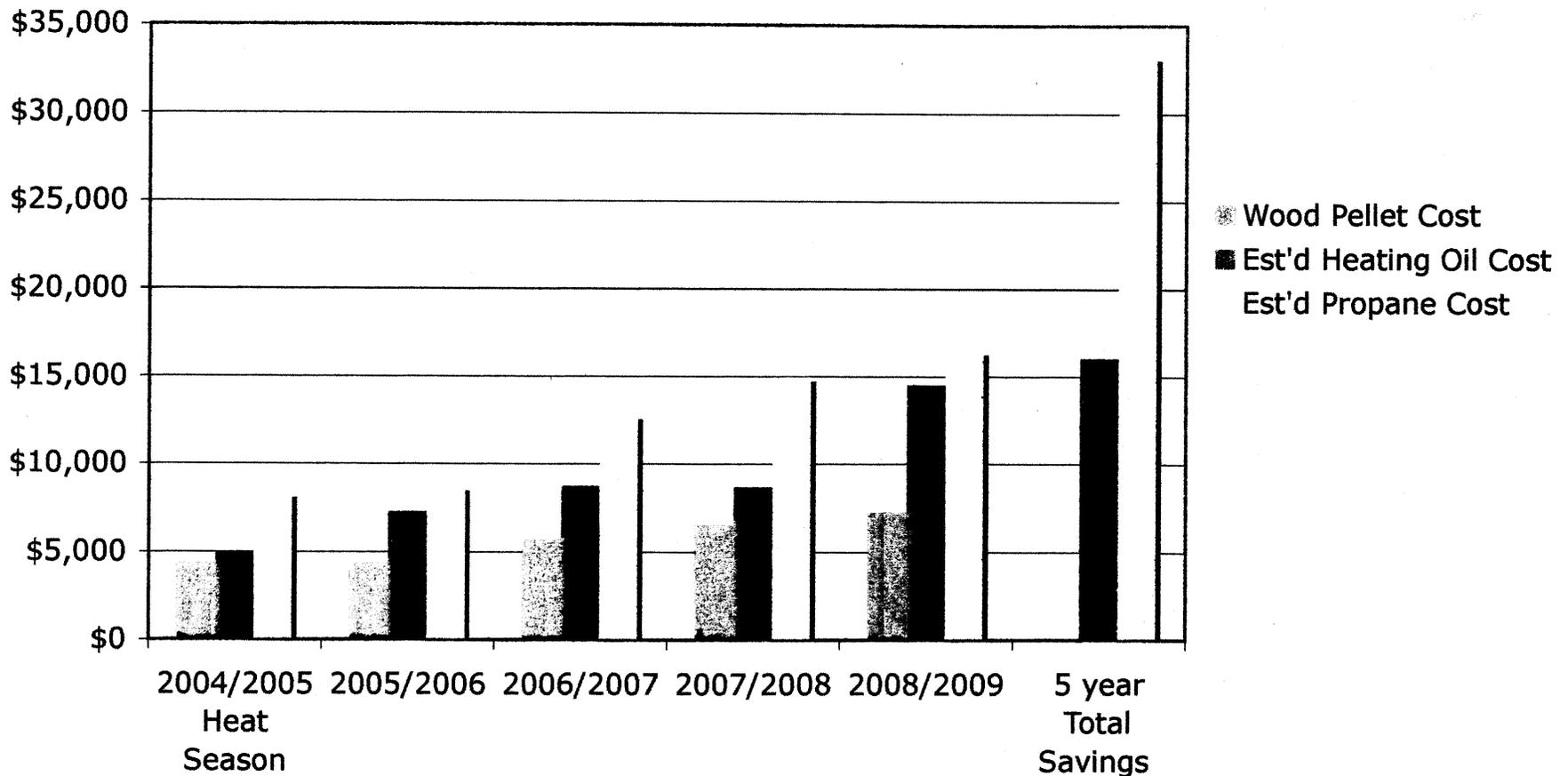


## Lyme Town Garage, estimated Savings of Heating with Wood Pellets vs. Heating Oil or Propane.
