- 3. "School: Interim Superintendent Frank Perotti the proposed financial changes in the school budget. The School Board had been asked to take a hard look at this budget. - 4. The following additional topics were discussed:

 - The Public hearing is coming up. The Budget Committee will review this budget and possibly decide to vote to present this next budget to be voted on at the next public hearing
