The Lyme Planning Board will meet on Thursday, January 14, 2021 at 7:00 PM. The Board will meet on-line via Zoom to consider the following items:

Item 1) The Lyme Planning Board will be holding a public hearing as required by RSA 675:3 for a proposed zoning amendment for Senior Housing. The intent of the amendment will be to promote housing that is suited to the needs of seniors located close to municipal and social services and facilities, and designed to facilitate independent living with an emphasis on safety and accessibility.

Item 2) David Russ, Eileen Fehskens and Brett and Teresa Burlison have applied to the Lyme Planning Board for a Lot Line Adjustment to exchange equal portions (.22 acres) of land between their lots at 7 and 8 Tavern Lane, tax map 407 lots 60.3 and 60.4.

Item 3) David Russ, Eileen Fehskens and Patricia Ploog, William Ploog have applied to the Lyme Planning Board for a Lot Line Adjustment to annex 5.05 acres from lots 56.3 and 56.3 to lot 55 and the remainder of lot 56.3 to be annexed to lot 56.2.
