### Item 1: Acceptance of minutes from 9/22/2022

### Item 2: Solar Energy Systems Zoning Amendment and Conditional Use Permit.

#### Item 4: Floodplain Ordinance update.

The Planning and Zoning Administrator had met with FEMA and representatives from the State Floodplain Management program. They have reviewed the Town's Floodplain ordinance and have asked the Planning Board to send to the Town as a Zoning Amendment changes to the Floodplain Ordinance. These changes are mostly changes in definitions and terminology. The Administrator passed out copies of the proposed changes for the Board members to review.

John asked that the Board members review the document so that it may be discussed at the next meeting on October 27th, 2022.

The Board intends to resume a discussion of a Housing Chapter for the Master Plan. Rich Brown asked that Board members think about, and be prepared to speak about, what they would like to see for housing in Lyme.
