Lyme Summer Pond Program Information for potential Counselors/ Volunteers and parents

Dear Potential Counselors/Volunteers,

The following informational letter outlining the roles and responsibilities of a summer recreation program for counselor/volunteer, although primarily addressed to counselors/volunteers, is important for parents to read and understand the expectations for these positions. Please read carefully and feel free to contact me with questions at (pondprogram@lymenh.gov).

The important thing that you must remember about working and/ or volunteering at the Pond Program this summer is that **YOU MUST BE RESPONSIBLE AND MATURE** as you are setting an example for the youth at the program. The program itself is designed for the young children of Lyme. You are asked to make this the first and foremost priority when you are at the pond, your best behavior is required. Although I consider this to be a fun job for the summer, it does take a fair amount of commitment and responsibility.

The Pond Program will be held 3 weeks in July. Legally no one under the age of 14 can be paid. Head Counselors need to complete the enclosed form and return it to me <u>after</u> <u>they have been hired</u>. All other counselor positions are on a volunteer basis and need to complete the enclosed form and return it to me by June 17, 2019.

Your expectations are as follows:

- All counselors must take Swimming lessons and wear appropriate suits (NO TWO PIECES!). The lessons begin at 8:30am sharp and last for ½ hour. The Pond Program is from 9:00 AM- 12:30 PM. Please be at the pond no later then 8:30am for morning meetings and ready to swim, NO EXCEPTIONS! Unless sick medical reason or emergency and I need to be notified of this asap.
- 2. You must be on time. Failure to be on time without notification to me will result in you being asked to relinquish your duties.
- 3. You must stay until all children have been picked up from the program, NO EXCEPTIONS!

- 4. The counselors hired by me (14+) will be head counselors and in charge of leading specific activities. Volunteer counselors will be expected to lead their group of campers to the activities, assist and encourage the children to play and have fun.
- You will NOT be allowed to socialize with friends while at the program. You are responsible for providing a safe, fun and active morning for the young children of Lyme. Save your socializing for after the program.
- 6. I will assign the grouping. I cannot guarantee volunteers any particular age group.
- 7. If the weather is rainy, you will receive a call by 7:30 am if the program needs to be cancelled.
- 8. For paid counselors, you will be given further information on work papers from me when the decision is made of hired
