Bill reported many people are interested in learning and play pickleball. This will be a recreation sanctioned adult sport. The Pickleball organizers, Bill Waste, Jo Steele, & Lynn Parshall will pick 2 times per week to hold the courts for pickleball. The courts are reserved for that time and Lyme residents and their guest may come and play pickleball.

Open use of the courts for individuals (from Lyme) would be basically the same as it is for tennis now.

When the resurfacing takes place on the Tennis Courts the Pickleball line will be done at the same time.

Chris reported the additional lining (because they are already there) will cost roughly \$600.00.

Jo will continue to get costs of netting, equipment and possible wind-screens-no estimates on this yet

The Grant request will be included in the Swan Fund already allocated for the Recreation Facility. The Recreation Commission will write to the Lyme Foundation to make sure they can use funds from the Swan Grant for these costs.
