The meeting was called to order at 7:30 PM by Chair Brotman.

- 1. The minutes of November 15<sup>th</sup> 2017 were reviewed:
  - Mr. Jones moved to approve the minutes of November 15<sup>th</sup>, 2017. Seconded by Mr. McClave. Voted unanimously in favor with minor corrections.
- 2. Mr. Valance reviewed the school budget (see attachment). The budget committee reviewed various scenarios and information pertaining to Trust funds and Capital Reserve funds.
- 3. Mr. Valance reviewed the roof condition. The need for this to be repaired was discussed.
- 4. The busing company and associated costs was discussed.
- 5. No new strategic incentives are planned for this budget cycle.
- 6. The board will be discussing the full day Kindergarten at its next meeting.
- 7. At this time Chair Brotman polled the Budget Committee members to make sure all questions had been asked and answered.
- 8. The group reviewed high school tuition figures.
- 9. An option for solar panels to be added to the roof was discussed.
- 10. Public Comments: Mr. Roby discussed low interest loans. Ms Santau discussed the struggle some residents are having in paying their taxes, and asked if there was a way to keep things from increasing so rapidly.
- 11. The fact that the tax base is not increasing was noted as a problem that adds to the struggle to pay keep taxes down.
- 12. The Budget Committee asked the School to come back to the next meeting with some information on both busing costs, and the roof repair for the community/gymnasium.
- 13. After a review of the total budget request it was the sense of the budget committee to support this budget.
- 14. At this time it was felt that the January 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2018 meeting was not needed.
- 15. The next meeting will be January 17<sup>th</sup>, 2018 at 7 pm to review the School and Town budgets.
- 16. At 9:10 PM Mr. Jones moved to adjourn. Seconded by Mr.McClave. Voted unanimously in favor.
