There will be 3 new opportunities to get a COVID vaccine locally after Christmas. The first two are in Orford and Lyme. See below for details.

- Both will be Walk-in clinics so no appointment needed.
- Both will be operated by the NH Mobile Vaccine Program with volunteer support from local organizations.
- Both will offer Pfizer, Moderna and Johnson and Johnson vaccines
- Both will offer vaccines for anyone age 5 years and older for 1rst, 2nd, 3rd or booster doses. Boosters are for those 16 yrs and older, 6 months after their last dose of primary vaccine series.
- Both clinics will have no residency requirements
- Children 18 and under will need a parent or guardian present to sign consent forms
- Please bring a form of identification. If you have a vaccine card from prior vaccine doses please bring it.

Monday December 27, 2021 in ORFORD

Orford Congregational Church from 11 am to 3 pm. Limited to 200 people, first come first served. Please expect a wait.

Wednesday December 29, 2021 in LYME

Lyme Fire Station from **9 am to 3 pm**. Limited to 350 people, cumulative over the day

The third opportunity will be **January 8, 2022 Upper Valley Region** for NH's second Booster Blitz- Details to be released after holidays but most likely will be by appointment only.
