

## FEE SCHEDULE

Fee Payment Cards or Stickers may be purchased at the Town Clerk's Office (M, W, F, 8:00am-2:00pm), Lyme Home & Hardware and the Lyme Country Store:

\$15- Fee Payment Card (Green Card)

\$15- Trash Bag Stickers (5 per sheet)

### **30 lb. Weight Limit on Bags.**

#### Bulky items:

The Transfer Station does not accept these items.

Bulky items include:

- Couches, Recliners, Futons, ect
- Mattresses, Box Springs
- Anything that would not typically go into your trash.

If you have any bulky items like this please bring them to the Lebanon Landfill.

#### Construction Materials

The Lyme Transfer Station cannot accept any materials that go into the construction of a home. These items include:

- Lumber of any type
- Roof shingles
- Bricks or Concrete
- Cabinets

These items can be taken to Hammond Grinding and Recycling in Canaan, NH and the Lebanon Landfill.

#### Tires:

Lyme Transfer Station does not Accept Tires. Tires can go to the Lebanon Landfill.

#### Refrigerators/Freon Items:

AC's, Dehumidifiers, Refrigerators, can go to Lebanon or Evergreen in Wilder.

## SAFETY

Safety is the primary concern at the Transfer Station. Please be extremely alert to potential hazards while driving into the transfer station. Come to a complete stop at the STOP sign. Follow the instructions of the attendants. They will alert you when you should approach the compactor and where to go for unloading.

- Approach the compactor in a single-file traffic pattern.
- **Stay in your vehicle while attendants unload trash and recycling.**
- **Any large loads of trash, or recycling will be instructed to pull off to the side. You will have to unload your vehicle as traffic allows.**
- No person shall be allowed to remove items from the metal bin.
- Watch for pedestrians when operating your vehicle and be alert for vehicles moving through the Transfer Station area.
- **No Dogs Allowed at the Transfer Station! This is for the safety of the workers unloading vehicles**

Please alert the attendants of any safety hazards you encounter.

#### Inclement weather regulations and closure of the Transfer station:

- ✓ The Transfer Station will be closed when the temperature is below 0.
- ✓ The Transfer Station will be closed during snow and ice storms.
- ✓ The Transfer Station will be closed during all electrical storms.

## TRASH & RECYCLING

The pay-as-you-throw and Recycling program provides a simple, fair and easy method for disposing of household trash and recyclable items.

### Here's how it works:

**Household trash:** must be in trash bags, tied shut or in a closed commercial bag. Neither bag may weigh over 30 pounds. Commercial bags require the use of a Green Payment Sticker.

**Bulky items and C+D Material:** These are all items that would not typically be put into your trash bags. Please bring these items to the Lebanon Landfill. They are open Mon-Fri 8:30-5:00 P.M. and Sat 8:30-2:00

**Glass:** Please separate your glass from other recyclables. Glass will go into a separate bin.

### Zero Sort Recycling as follows:

The Containers it **can** take:

- Plastic bottles, jugs, tubs, & lids with a #1 - #7 (Cleansed Out No waste in Containers)
- Aluminum cans
- Tin and other metal cans

The Fibers it **can** take:

- Newspapers
- Office paper
- Computer paper
- Soft cover books
- Magazines
- Manila envelopes
- Envelopes
- Junk mail

▪ Hard cover books (no covers)  
The Cardboard it **can** take:

- Cardboard (clean)
- Box Board
- Egg Cartons
- Rolls

## Items Not Accepted in Zero-Sort

- **NO Plastic Bags or Bagged Recycling** (Clean Plastic Bags can go to some Grocery Stores or donated to the Haven)
- **NO Coated Paper Items.** (Items with a plastic lining such as waxed coffee or soda cups, waxed paper plates)
- **NO Disposable Items.** (Styrofoam, napkins, paper towels, tissues, plastic utensils, dirty recycling, condiment packets, straws)
- **NO Toys, Hangers, Clothes, or Shoes.**
- **NO Waste or Wood.** (Rope, Twine, Diapers, food, pet & yard waste)
- **NO Plastic Wrap, Films or Tarps.** (Food bags or wrappers, plastic or shrink wrap & tarps)
- **NO Ceramic, Pots, Pans, or Baking Glass.**
- **NO Hazardous Materials**
- **NO Medical Waste**
- **NO Rubber or Scrap Metal**
- **NO Electronics, Batteries or Bulbs**

**All Zero-Sort should be in an open top bin or an easy to dump container. Do not put Zero-Sort into plastic bags. Make sure there is no food waste in your recycling.**

### Fluorescent Bulbs and Mercury:

- We accept fluorescent bulbs and mercury devices at the transfer station for FREE! Please ask an attendant if you are unsure about your items.

### Batteries:

- We accept batteries at the Transfer Station. Please ask an attendant. **Lithium batteries are especially dangerous and can cause fire. Please use caution with them and do not throw them in your trash.**



Hazardous Household Waste, oil based paint, gasoline, insecticides, asbestos, automobile batteries, tanks, any flammable, caustic or toxic substances and unwanted medicines **cannot** be disposed of at the Lyme Transfer Station. Household Hazardous Waste collection days are held periodically through the Upper Valley Hazardous Waste organization. [www.uvhhw.org](http://www.uvhhw.org)

Electronics collection day is held at the Lyme Transfer station once yearly. A fee will be paid to an outside vendor. Microwaves, computer/computer parts, televisions, printers, copiers, scanners, VCR's, DVD players etc. must be held at home until the designated day.

**When in doubt, ask the attendant!**
