

Tennis Courts

Rules and Regulations:

1. Weather permitting, the tennis and pickleball courts are open from the first week in May through the last week of October (*depending on snow*).
If we by chance get snow while the courts are open there is no shoveling of snow, you will need to wait until it melts.
2. The courts are for the use of Lyme residents and their accompanied guests.
3. All recreation areas will be closed from dusk to dawn (with the exception of authorized events)
4. Soft soled shoes only during court uses.
5. No bicycles, skateboards, roller-skates, rollerblades or pets are allowed on the courts.
6. No food or breakable objects are permitted in the court enclosure.
7. Whenever there are players waiting, all players must vacate courts after playing for 1 hour. (*Let's share the time so all can use this facility*) (*unless you have reserved the court*)
8. Players waiting to use a court must indicate in some clear polite way to those using the courts that they are waiting to use the court.
9. Use of the tennis and pickleball courts must be conducted in a safe manner with due respect and consideration for others who are sharing the courts as well as for those who live in the nearby areas, particularly during early morning and late evening play. Court rules and courtesies apply at all times. Rough play or abusive conduct is not permitted
10. No group, club, or organization shall occupy tennis or pickleball courts for tournament or recreational play without written permission from the Recreation Commission.
11. No for-profit entities or individuals are to use the courts for tennis or pickleball lessons. Personal financial gain selling or services shall NOT occur at this facility.
12. Recreation Commission shall have priority use on all courts. A schedule of Recreation Commission court usage is available on our website @ www.Lymenh.gov but is subject to change at any time.
